Arizona City Sanitary District has an opening for Plant Superintendent of the Wastewater Treatment Plant. Under limited supervision, plans, organizes, directs and supervises the Operations Staff and activities of the Wastewater Treatment Plant and ADHS Certified Laboratory.

Experience and Education: Must have a minimum of seven (7) years wastewater collection and treatment operational and maintenance program experience, including experience in operating an SBR type plant and two (2) years of management experience. Must also have experience in laboratory operations and procedures, including conducting analytical analysis.

Must have an ADEQ Wastewater Treatment Certification Grade IV, ADEQ Wastewater Collections Certification Grade II, ability to obtain ADEQ Wastewater Collections Certification Grade III within 12-months of hire and an ADEQ Wastewater Collections Certification Grade IV with 24-months hire.

Must possess a High School Diploma or GED Equivalent and have a valid State of Arizona Driver's License and a clean driving record.

The Arizona City Sanitary District conducts a pre-employment CDL Physical and Drug Screen on all prospective employees.
